Description of Project:

To strengthen our mass market donor pipeline, Mercy Corps is seeking a new agency partner(s) to help us reach new mission-focused donors through our direct mail acquisition program. We are looking for partner(s) to help us manage our own rental list, reach out to other list managers/brokerages to help us tap into new markets and negotiate prices on our behalf, and provide best in class data hygiene procedures to help our fundraising campaigns reach their intended audiences.

Background

Mercy Corps is a leading global organization powered by the belief that a better world is possible. In disaster, in hardship, in more than 40 countries around the world, we partner to put bold solutions into action — helping people triumph over adversity and build stronger communities from within. Now, and for the future.

If your company does not provide all three services, we invite you to still submit an expression of interest. Companies will not be disqualified from participating in the later RFP process if they do not offer all of the aforementioned services – we are looking for best in class service, not a one-size-fits-all agency.

Expression of Interest

In order to be considered as a potential supplier, interested individuals/entities should...

- 1. Express your interest in participating by submitting a one page cover letter;
- 2. Submit a company profile (NOT to exceed five pages) demonstrating your experience with direct mail acquisition, list brokerage/management, and/or data merge/purge and data hygiene protocols. This is not a proposal but is intended as an opportunity to demonstrate your value proposition and indicate your capacity to deliver new leads and potential donors on behalf of Mercy Corps. Please also indicate whether your company can offer all or some of these services we are seeking as part of this tender: List Brokerage, List Management, and Merge Data Processing Services;
- 3. Include a signed Non-Disclosure Agreement (annex 1 attached)

Request For Expression of Interest (EoI)

After Wednesday, March 8th 2023, you will be notified whether you are invited to participate in the tender process. We will then share the full Request for Proposal (RFP) and you will have one week for questions and another week to prepare your proposal. All RFP submissions will be due on March 24, 2023. After reviewing all the proposals, shortlisted agencies will be asked to interview with a selection committee before a final decision is made.
